FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Stories announcing births are common in the Bible. In the Hebrew (Old Testament) scriptures, we have stories of announcing the birth of Isaac, Samson and Samuel. and in the New Testament, the birth of John the Baptist is recorded by St Luke. The purpose of an annunciation story is to let us know the role of the person will play in salvation history rather than a strict record of a conversation.

In the annunciation of the birth of Jesus, there are elements surpassing all previous stories. These key elements are the creative action of the Holy Spirit, Mary's cooperation with God's will, and that Jesus is Son of God who will reign forever (cf "Summit" Vol 38 No. 4) In the Church, we have a long tradition of honouring Mary. In 1965, at the Vatican Council, the Church solemnly taught Mary as the first disciple and model for all disciples. As such, she is Mother of the Church and Mother of God. As we reflect on Mary's perfect "yes" to God's will, where am I now being called to say "yes" to enable God to live more deeply within me? Maybe my response will cause my life to change as did Mary's after the Annunciation.

The Year of 2011 in Review

During this year we have welcomed 131 new members to our community through Baptism and farewelled 22 parishioners at Funeral celebrations.

Our two schools began with extensive new buildings funded by the Federal Government. We no longer have portable classrooms, but permanent facilities.

On your behalf, I thank our generous givers to Thanksgiving Offering who have given an increase of 7.5% during 2011 compared to 2010. Because of your generosity, we have been able to meet our running expenses (eg. annual insurance \$24650) and continue to repay our loans. Our current parish debt is \$458662. The school debts are not included in this figure.

2011 has seen significant changes in staff in our parish office and schools.

This year the Jill Gibbs Memorial Community Garden was established on Riddell Road. A new sound system installed in St Anne's church and various parish buildings have been

As I look back, we have enjoyed a very good year. Let us thank God for all his blessings and gifts.
