Thirty-Third Sunday of Ordinary Time

"Trust in God- not a hair of your head will be lost" (Luke 21:19)

St Luke wrote these words (Luke 21:5-19) after the destruction of the Temple in Jerusalem in 70AD. The passage was written to give comfort and hope to his readers who knew of the annihilation of the Temple and who were persecuted by he Roman occupiers for their refusal to worship the Roman emperor as a god and by the Jews who had expelled them from the synagogues for their faith in Jesus as Messiah. Jesus is warning his followers not to place their trust in those who purport to know God's plan for the end of time. Rather, they should know God is with them no matter what happens.

Caritas Australia- Haiyan Typhoon Appeal

Caritas Australia has already sent \$1 million to Caritas Philippines. In Samar, where the storm first struck land, 733000 lived. Days later many residents have still not been contactable and thousands are reported missing.

We have seen on our TV's, hundreds searching for water and food. Pope Francis said the damage is enormous.

Poverty in our land of Plenty

This week, Australian Council of Social Service (ACOSS) released its research into the state of poverty in Australia. Using the same poverty line as in Britain, Ireland and European Union, they found that 11.8% of Australian including 869000 children, lived below the poverty line in 2012, up from 9.3% in 2010.

Last month, St Vincent de Paul Society National Council published its report: "Two Australia's: A report into poverty in the land of plenty." The report states that we Australians are the ninth most unequal citizens of the 34 developed countries. Over 40 years, full time wages have increased 59% for highest incomes while only by 15% for the lowest incomes. Vinnies is advocating for a \$50 increase in the Newstart payment.
