THE TRUE IDENTITY OF JESUS

In today's Gospel (Luke 9:18-24), we hear Peter proclaim: 'You are the Christ of God.' This inspired insight is good, so far as it goes.

But Jesus knew Peter very well. His birth name was 'Simon'. Jesus changed that to 'Peter'. It was a nickname full of irony. It means 'rock' in Greek and conveys the idea of rock solid. But for this effervescent, changeable fisherman, 'Sandy' might have been more accurate than 'Rocky'.

If anyone could claim to understand the true identity of Jesus, but then completely misunderstand it, it was Peter. So, he was told to keep guiet.

Nevertheless, grace had been given to Peter to find correct words to express the faith of the disciples.

This is still the role of the successor of St Peter. By the grace of God, the Pope is to find the right words to express the faith of the followers of Jesus. So he may lead the world to a deeper understanding of the identity of Jesus, that He is: the body language of God, the conqueror of death, the vanquisher of the grave, the One who will transfigure our bodies in the light of his resurrection.

We could pause for a moment to pray for Pope Francis that he will continue to proclaim the true identity of Jesus of Nazareth in inspired language which can inspire the whole of humanity.

OUR PRAYERFUL SYMPATHY: we offer to Dan Gavaghan, our new parishioner as his sister, Mary Gavaghan RSJ entered eternal life last Sunday. To some in our parish, she was Aunty Mary; to others she was Sister Mary. In 1928 she was born of Irish parents in England. She was Principal of OLMC School from 1980 to 1985. A number of her relatives and parishioners including Father Kevin took part in her Funeral Mass at the Josephite Centre in Hawthorn East on Friday.

DIAMOND JUBILEE OF FR JIM FEENAN: we shall celebrate next Sunday when he visits us. Born in Northern Ireland in 1926, he received his formation as a priest at Carlow in the Republic of Ireland. After being ordained on 10 June 1956, he came to Melbourne. In 1973, he was appointed parish priest of Sunbury. With the opening of the airport at Tullamarine in 1970, Sunbury was beginning to grow. In 1974, he oversaw the purchase of land for another school in Stewarts Lane. At the Parish Education Board they named the new school St Anne's.

Fr Jim began celebrating Mass each Saturday at Sunbury Training Centre later called Caroola. He also commenced religious education for children at government schools. He helped renovate the convent and presbytery. In 1977, he was appointed parish priest at Manifold Heights in Geelong from where he retired in 1990. Since then, he has assisted parishes in the Geelong area and Bellarine Peninsula.

FINAL WORDS OF POPE ST JOHN XXIII: in 1915, Loris Capovilla was born in northern Italy. His father died when he was 7. Loris was ordained a priest for Venice in 1940. In 1953, he became a close friend and secretary to Cardinal Angelo Roncalli, the archbishop of Venice. He continued his service in Rome in 1958 when Roncalli was elected as Pope John XXIII. In 1963, as the Pope was dying, he thanked Capovilla for his years of service. He said: "We have worked. We have served. We have loved. We have not stopped to gather the stones which were thrown against us from one side or the other of the way, to throw them back." Later, Capovilla became a bishop and a cardinal. He died on 26 May 2016, aged 100 years.Kevin McIntosh


