THE FESTIVAL OF THE PATRON SAINTS OF OUR PARISH OUR PAST

Our Parish can be looked at from three dimensions—its past, its present and its future. Our first reading today from the Old Testament, Book of Sirach, honours the ancestors in the Hebrew faith. The reading praises those who have gone before. On our feast day, let us give honour to those who have gone before us in the faith. Those who gathered in homes to celebrate the Eucharist led by the priest riding his horse from Coburg from 1852. Later, in 1864, Fr James Moore from Keilor gave the name to the church being built as "Our Lady of Mount Carmel"- the Catholics few in number in the small village of Sunbury paying for the church that opened in 1874. In our time let us give thanks to our parents, teachers and others who have handed on their faith to us.

Our Present Parish

Our second reading from St Paul's first letter to the Corinthians exhorts us to serve one another. We have been gifted with various talents given by the Holy Spirit. Today, we give thanks for all the obvious and the hidden services and ministries carried out by our parishioners week in and week out. There are over thirty areas of service—not only to parishioners and also to the wider community; eq Vinnies.

In our service to others, we can be confident the Holy Spirit is present within us. As the child leapt in the womb of Elizabeth through the gift of the holy Spirit was empowered to interpret the leaping of her son John as the result of the presence of the incarnate Christ in Mary.

Our Future Parish

"The Parish is not an outdated institution," wrote Pope Francis in 2013, "precisely because it possesses great flexibility. It can assume quite different contours depending on the openness and missionary creativity of the pastor and community."

A parish is called to be an evangelizing parish, as Jesus said, "I chose you from the world, to go and bear fruit that will last." (John 15:16) The fruit is the spiritual and personal change of members. The making of disciples is the litmas test of an evangelizing parish. Parishes that seriously and consistently make disciples experience astonishing levels of growth in depth and number. "Disciples are hungry to pray and worship, so naturally Mass attendance goes up. Disciples want to serve, and often migrate into parish leadership. Disciples will fill every faith formation class in your parish and diocese, because they want to grow in their faith. They clamour to discern personal vocation and personal call... Disciples go to great lengths to pass on the faith to their children. They care about the poor and about justice. They take risks for the kingdom of God. Disciples give!" (Weddell, "Discipleship: The key to fruitfulness" 24)

At our Melbourne Priests Annual Inservice in early June, a strategy to begin this vision was the endorsement of Alpha, a program which was held some 14 years ago in our parish. As we continue as a parish, may we continue our trust in our loving God following the example of Mary, Mother of the Church and Our Lady of Mt Carmel who was praised by her cousin Elizabeth "Blessed is she who believed that the promise made her by the Lord would be fulfilled." (Luke 1:45)
