THE TWOFOLD COMMAND TO LOVE

As we move through Matthew's gospel, there is growing tension between Jesus and some of the Jewish leaders. Last Sunday, we heard of the conflict about paying taxes to the Roman Caesar.

There are many commandments in the Hebrew Scriptures and rabbis debated which is the greatest. Jesus quotes from Jewish scriptures well known to his listeners— Deuteronomy 6:5 and Leviticus 19:18.

However, Jesus teaches two new things: the personal testimony of his own unconditional love of God and neighbour, and the revelation that in him the infinite love of God has taken flesh and dwelt among us. Love know no bounds.

ASSISTED SUICIDE/ EUTHANASIA BILL: On 11 October, the Victorian leaders of the six major religions— the Buddhists, the Christians, the Hindus, the Jews, the Moslems and Sikhs which covers 66% of Victorians met in Melbourne and expressed their opposition to the bill to the Parliamentarians. Those who say they are no religion in Victoria are 33%. All the religions are against it. Yet our local member in the lower house voted in favour of the bill. This week, the bill will be voted on in the upper house where our local member has expressed his opposition to the bill.

Opposition to the bill is growing as people reflect more on the implications of proposed legislation. The Victorian AMA is against it, Palliative Care Victoria is against it. Practising medical doctors say they see more elder abuse than painful deaths these days. Please pray for the defeat of this bill and ask for more loving care to our dying Victorians so that they do not feel a burden on others.
