#### ON THE JOURNEY OF FAITH BY ST LUKE

St Luke's Gospel and the Acts of the Apostles also written by Luke are the two volumes of a single work that today we should call "a history of the rise of Christianity'. Luke, a close friend of St Paul, was a Syrian from Antioch a medical doctor and a convert from paganism. Being a doctor, he highlights Jesus' compassion for the sick and needy.

Luke's Gospel is the story of Jesus' journey to Jerusalem to the cross and resurrection. Acts is the journey of the Gospel spreading from Jerusalem to "all the nations'. A unifying theme in Luke is that of journey. On the eight Sundays of the Easter season we listen to readings from the Acts of the Apostles.

## **NOURISHMENT FOR THE JOURNEY**

In Luke's Gospel Jesus is often depicted as sharing meals with his disciples and others. In today's Gospel reading, the disciples give the risen Jesus some grilled fish to eat. (Luke 24:43) Meanwhile, Jesus opens the minds of the disciples to the truth of the Word. These two elements - Word and Eucharist—continue to nourish our faith.

St Fulgentius, Bishop of Tunisia, North Africa (died in 527) wrote: "For the cup we drink is a participation in the Blood of Christ, and the bread we break is a participation in the Body of Christ. Because there is one loaf, we who are many are one body, since we all share the same bread." It was inspiring that the majority in our full church on Holy Thursday received Holy Communion under both kinds.

# **NOURISHED FOR EVANGELISATION**

The risen Jesus opens up limitless horizons to go out and spread the good news..."preaching repentance for the forgiveness of sins...to all nations' (Luke 24:47)

Pope Francis extends this missionary mandate to all of us: "Every Christian is challenged, here and now, to be actively engaged in evangelization; indeed, anyone who has truly experienced God's saving love does not need much time or lengthy training to go out and proclaim that love. Every Christian is a missionary to the extent that he or she has encountered the love of God in Christ Jesus: we no longer say that we are 'disciples' and missionaries', but rather that we are always 'missionary disciple' (*The Joy of the Gospel #120*)

**ANZAC DAY MASS:** To mark the centenary of the end of World War 1 Australian Bishops have produced a special Mass prayers, readings for Anzac Day to be celebrated in OLMC Church at 9am. Prayer Service at Sunbury War Memorial will follow.

**POPE EMERITUS BENEDICT PRAISES POPE FRANCIS:** On 12 March Pope Benedict XVI released a surprise letter on the fifth anniversary of Pope Francis' election containing a sharp rebuke to those seeking to present Francis' papacy as marking a rupture with his own. Benedict said there was an "interior continuity between him and Francis, admitting differences in style and temperament."

**NEW CANONISED SAINTS:** Pope Francis has ratified miraculous intercessions of Pope Paul VI who will be canonized in October and of the martyred Archbishop Oscar Romero who may be canonized at World Youth Day in Panama next January.
