"GO TELL MY PEOPLE" (AMOS 7:15)

As we rejoice in the rescue of the twelve youths and their coach from the cave in Thailand we can reflect on the role of the coach in the ordeal. It is reported he is an ordained Buddhist monk which enabled him to lead his team in meditation and prayer which helped keep up the boy's spirits and to rely on each other.

In Thailand, Buddhist monks go out every morning with a bowl which is filled with food by devoted householders. That is the monks food for the day. A monk only eats if people are generous. Today, Jesus teaches his first disciples to take no bread for the journey and not to move to a house with better food (Mark 6:8-10). The disciples are to rely on the hospitality of others.

Sent out in Pairs: Jesus sent his disciples in twos. When we are engaged in ministry it is important we seek and provide mutual support. When we minister together, we feel more confident as we reach out to others. By sharing ministry and receiving support from others in ministry, we can continue on- hence Vinnies and Legion of Mary work in pairs. I know how supportive are my weekly and fortnightly meetings with our parish team and our three principals. In our discernment phase of the Plenary Council we will gather in groups to listen together to the Holy Spirit.

Shake the dust from your Feet: If there is no welcome, they must move on. Shaking the dust from their feet was a strong symbol of wanting nothing more to do with that place. This is good advice- to move on; not to carry with us our guilt or a sense of failure or anger- let it go- which the counsellors testify is one of the hardest things we have to do.

We need to discern when to stay and when to leave. As Archbishop Mark Coleridge told us last Sunday in the video on the Plenary Council, we Catholics have to discern what to keep and what to change in the mission of our Australian Church.

A Centenary of Missionary Service: is being celebrated this year by the Columban Fathers. Founded in Ireland in 1918, they came to Melbourne in 1921. Their magazine "The Far East" gives us news of their missionary activity around the

The World Meeting of Families 2018: is being held in Ireland next month, attended by Pope Francis. All the free 80000 tickets for an event at Croke Park. Dublin are gone, while the 500000 tickets to the Mass at Phoenix Park on 26 August are being taken up steadily.

Violent Attacks on Priests and Churches: In Mexico, the bishops have published security protocols to protect priests and church property. In 2017, Mexico suffered its worst year of violence with 29000 murders recorded. Since January 2013, 24 priest have been murdered in Mexico.

70th Anniversary of World Council of Churches (WCC): on 21 June, Pope Francis visited Geneva to mark the anniversary. His one-day visit was an occasion of joy and gratitude for all the WCC had contributed to the unity and cooperation between the WCC and the Catholic Church.

Repairs to Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church: began on Friday. The repairs are needed due to the damage to the front entrance by termites.

Our Prayerful Sympathy: we offer to Lorraine Lilburne as Laurie her husband of 54 years entered eternal life after a brief illness. Laurie and Lorraine came to our parish in 2001 from New Zealand.
