Parish Vision: Christlike relationships of friendship and faith, valuing one another and sharing our gifts for the good of all

"I CAME TO SERVE, NOT TO BE SERVED." (MARK 10:45)

The night before Jesus died for us, he celebrates his last meal with his friends. Jesus rises and lays aside his garments to perform an act of service; next day, he will lay aside his own life. The "hour" has come: the hour of Jesus' love for his own to the very end, the hour when the Father has given all things into his hands.

John's gospel reminds us by the washing of the feet, this "parable in action", that Jesus is Servant, one who is ready to do the dirty jobs, to be at the bottom of society with the poor, the refugees, the unemployed, those living with a disability, etc.

THE HOMELINESS OF GOD: Peter finds Jesus as Servant hard to accept. He wants a Jesus who is Master, in whom Peter can feel secure. Rather than a powerful Messiah, Jesus kneels on the floor. To put one's feet in another's hands makes one vulnerable. Julian of Norwich described the scene as "the courtesy or homeliness of God." Jesus gives us an example: to get down and serve one another, despite the dust and smell and misunderstandings; to be hospitable to our sisters and brothers. "I have given you an example so that you may copy what I have done to you." (John 13:5)

BEETHOVEN'S 250TH BIRTHDAY: is being celebrated around the world this year. His music "Ode to Joy" is used in our singing the "Gloria" at our Masses. He was born in Bonn, Germany in 1770. While his date of birth is uncertain, he was baptised on 17 December 1770. He composed 722 works. He composed "Ode to Joy" in 1824 in Vienna.

THE JOURNEY OF LENT AND EASTER: League footballers often remark that the pre-season training is the least pleasant time in the year. Lent is a season of preparing us for our renewal of our commitment to Christ and his Church when we shall renew our Baptismal promises on Easter Sunday.

Lent can be seen positively as a time of taking on more, rather than giving up things— of making more time for prayer, for service to others, etc.

SUNBURY INTER-CHURCH COUNCIL: is also called Lay Ecumenical Council Inc. (LEC) which is made up of members of the seven Churches of Sunbury and coordinates prayer services and outreach. The Council meets about eight times a year. The Annual General Meeting is on Tuesday 25 February at 7.30pm at St Mary's Church Office, O'Shannassy St. More members are sought to join the group.

2021 SCHOOL ENROLMENTS– INFORMATION SESSIONS: our three Parish Schools will hold an Information Session at our Parish Centre on Thursday 12 March at 9.30am and 7pm for parents wishing to apply for enrolment next year. As our schools are very popular, late applications can be disadvantaged. This year, 1062 children are being educated at our schools.

OUR PRAYERFUL SYMPATHY: we offer to Marilyn and Angela as their brother, Father Rod Pitts entered eternal life last Saturday aged 77 years. Rod attended CBC Parade College and then gained a science degree. He then began his formation as a priest and was ordained in 1971. He was in Forest Hill Parish for 15 years before his retirement due to dementia. Rod and I grew up six houses apart in the same street in East Preston. Rod used to take me to school. Later, he designed my ordination vestment. His Funeral is on Tuesday at 11am in St Timothy's Church, Forest Hill.

ASH WEDNESDAY: is on **Wednesday 26 February** and is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat:

Prayer Self-Denial Helping Others
 Those over 14 years are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
 All who have completed their 18th year and not yet begun their 60th year are bound to fast.
 During Lent we are asked to devote ourselves in a special manner to prayer, engage in works of charity and be penitent.

Each Catholic is obliged to receive Holy communion at least once per year. This precept must be fulfilled between Ash Wednesday 26 February and Trinity Sunday 7 June.

Feedback from our Parish Survey advised that a review of the allocation and management of parish keys is required. To address this issue all locks to St Anne's Church, Parish Office and Parish Centre will be changed over the next few weeks. Application forms for new keys are available from the Parish Office and in the entrance to St Anne's Church for parishioners who require access to these buildings. When the new keys are issued an alarm code will also be provided. Once the transition to the new keys has been completed the alarms to St Anne's Church will be activated. The Management of Parish keys will follow the guidelines of our insurer, Catholic Church Insurance.
