ON THANKSGIVING CAMPAIGNS - AN INITIAL REFLECTION

Over three Sundays during March we undertook a Parish Thanksgiving Campaign. At the time I noted that were doing this because we have not had such a campaign since 2019. That there are many new parishioners in our parish. Finally it was the responsible thing to do because there are moments on the journey when we have to stop, make an assessment of where we are, renew our vision and commitment and take decisions that help move us into the future.

So how did it go? I do not want to begin with money but people. The small committee to organize the Campaign were dedicated, thoughtful and hard working. Their dedication enabled us to put into place the Archdiocesan Program rather than paying for a program. So on behalf of the parish, thank you Dwain Lemaire, Mary MacDermid and Tony Kiley.

A small group of hard working volunteers entered all the census cards and pledges into the Pacem computer program. A key action item for the campaign. Our Parish secretaries became experts at answering questions about pledge cards and direct debiting and all kinds of other campaign details. A group hand delivered pledge cards on their daily walks and three parishioners spoke at Mass about what the parish meant to them. Thanks to them all.

So how did the campaign go? It empowered the service of a committed group of people for the sake of the parish so it was successful.

I also note that 600 people completed census cards that helped update our parish records. That is an ongoing process.

An initial assessment of how the Thanksgiving program assisted our financial position will need some time to judge. Pledges for the direct debiting and credit cards increased weekly contributions by 28% for the church account - that's \$601 increase. There was a strong increase for the presbytery account as well but without a reliable pledge figure from the past makes it hard to calculate the percentage increase. There were 46 new givers and 70 ongoing givers with increased giving. For this campaign a total of 116 givers offered a pledge.

However we are unable to calculate immediately a regular any increase in the cash collection or the tap and give. We will have to wait and see if this increases. Our quarterly financial bulletin report will keep us informed. Stay tuned.

Finally I would judge the campaign successful if it helped all of us be aware that the financial sustainability of our parish is a serious matter that we realistically need to think about. Like any household, we need to ponder how our weekly collections need to juggle the budget for both everyday "bread and butter issues", support particular needs such as the maintenance and repairs for both our church buildings and relate to other sources of parish income and our savings.

- Congratulations, Fr Denis, on your election to the Standing Committee of the Victorian Council of Churches (VCC). Representing the Catholic Archdiocese of Melbourne on this council is indeed a great honour.
 One task of the VCC is organising the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity.
- 2. <u>Week of Prayer for Christian Unity</u> In addition to individual prayers, the Ecumenical Service this year will take place in St Andrew's Uniting Church at 2pm on Saturday 7th June. The 2025 theme is: "... and whoever lives and believes in me will never die. "Do you believe this?" (John 11:26). The prayers and reflections were prepared by the brothers and sisters of the monastic community of Bose in northern Italy.
- 3. June 5th is World Environment Day and the call is to tackle plastic pollution. Pope Francis lamented pollution of the oceans and land. "Throwing away plastic in the sea is criminal. This kills biodiversity, the Earth, everything." Plastic pollution permeates every corner of the planet even our own bodies in the form of microplastics. In two months, countries meet again to continue negotiating a global treaty to end plastic pollution. Locally, can each of us spend time reducing/ avoiding single-use plastics, reusing items, and recycling properly? Can we call on authoritative people we know who can help build the momentum necessary to get action on this enormous problem? Pope Francis called on Catholics to act now before it's too late.
